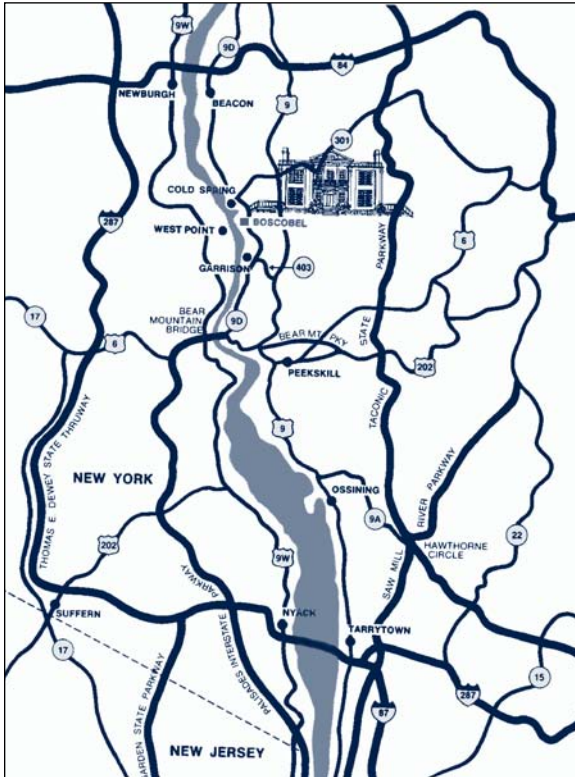




About The Festival
